
Subject: - Incorporation of new policy condition against HS Code 1006 40 00.

S.O. (E) The Central Government, in exercise of powers conferred by Section 3 read with section 5 of the Foreign Trade (Development & Regulation) Act, 1992 (No. 22 of 1992), as amended, read with Para 1.02 and 2.01 of the Foreign Trade Policy, 2015-20, hereby incorporates new Policy condition against ITC (HS) code 1006 40 00 of Chapter 10 of Schedule 2 of the ITC (HS) Export Policy, as under:

ITC HS Codes	Description	Export Policy	New Policy Condition
1006	Organic Non-Basmati Broken Rice (ITC HS Code 1006 40 00)	Prohibited	However, export of Organic Non-basmati rice, <b>including Organic Non-basmati broken rice</b> , will be governed as per provisions under Notification No.03/2015-2020 dated 19 <sup>th</sup> April, 2017.
